

1. SCOPE

This statement clarifies KEYMILE's product compliance with the European Union's directive 2012/19/EC, Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment ("WEEE" directive) and similar regulations that may be adopted by other countries. WEEE is intended to reduce the disposal of waste from electrical and electronic equipment by establishing guidelines for prevention, reuse, recycling and recovery.

2. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WEEE DIRECTIVE

- 13/08/05: All KEYMILE products that are placed on the market within the EC are labeled according to WEEE / EN 50419. An exception is valid for products that are placed on the German market as the labelling starts not until 24/03/2006 according to German laws (ElektroG).
- 23/11/05: Registration of KEYMILE with the EAR (Elektro-Altgeräte-Register, register for old electric appliances) and report of devices placed in the market and taken back.
- 24/03/06: All KEYMILE products placed on the market within the EC are labelled according to WEEE / EN 50419.

3. CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY

KEYMILE intends to assign the responsibility of transport and disposal of WEEE to the customer as follows:

The Customer shall be responsible for the disposal of Hardware delivered under a Contract in compliance with the provisions of any national legislation enacted in pursuance of EU Directive 2012/19/EC (as may be amended from time to time) at his own expense. The Customer hereby indemnifies KEYMILE from its obligations (manufacturer liability of redemption) and with it from any related claims of third parties. This exemption is also valid in case of resale or hand over of the item from the Customer to a third party. The obligations of the Customer under this clause in respect of each individual item of Hardware expire two (2) years following the date of receipt by KEYMILE of written notice from the Customer that the Hardware item is no longer in use, provided said item is not used during that time.

4. WEEE COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

KEYMILE, as a producer of telecommunication equipment, is committed to complying with the WEEE directive. KEYMILE implemented the WEEE directive as described under "2. Implementation of the WEEE Directive". The assignment of the responsibility of transport and disposal of WEEE to the customer (3. Customer Responsibility) has to be negotiated between KEYMILE and the customers.
